Dear Coach,

This year begins JLYSSL's relationship with SAY Soccer, our new affiliate for our U6-U8 programs. SAY was chosen by the JLYSSL board because of its well regarded support for recreational soccer and coaches, and because of its simplified administration.

If you are familiar with CYSA (which remains our affiliate for U10+ programs), you'll note that certain forms – the CYSA 1601 player forms and the CYSA 1628 coach form – are no longer required. Instead SAY allows the league to manage registration in a much more flexible manner.

SAY Soccer has a few requirements of which you must be aware:

1. Each coach must complete a SAY Volunteer Application Form.
2. Each player's guardian must sign the team's SAY Hold Harmless Form.
3. SAY Soccer's "Times Two" policy requires that TWO adults be present at any team function. It is suggested that the adults not be related. **THIS IS IMPORTANT.**

Once you, the coach, complete the SAY Volunteer Application Form and have each player's guardian sign the Hold Harmless Form, you merely need to fold them together, staple them, and drop them in the mail.
